

SENDING SCORES

Scores must be sent directly to colleges from the College Board or ACT. You, the student, or CSH cannot send an official set of scores – it must come directly from the testing service.

SAT's

When you request any SAT score to be sent to a college, the testing service will send the most recent score and ALL of your previous scores (SAT I and II are included).

1. When you register for your **last** SAT, request that your scores be sent to four colleges. When you register, you receive four free reports – this will save you \$28.00.
2. If you apply to more colleges, request that a report be sent to the other colleges to which you plan to apply. You can request score reports:

 - Telephone: (800) 728-7267
 - If you take another SAT after you request your score reports, you will need to send your scores again. So, be sure to send your scores after the LAST SAT that you take (I or II)

ACT's

Choose your highest score and request that report to be sent to the colleges. (THIS IS DIFFERENT FROM THE SAT PROGRAM.)

- If you request scores to be sent to four colleges when you register, you will save \$32.00.
- Request scores at www.actstudent.org or (319) 337-1000

If you are applying to the UC's

- Remember that they require an SAT I and two SAT II's (Writing, Math, and another subject).
- They will accept scores through the December test date if there is no delay (ie.

late registration, changes between registering and the test date).

- If they do not receive your scores, they will NOT notify you. They will simply not factor them into your academic index. In other words, they will add a 0 when they should be adding a number in the thousands.
